























Shiny toy syndrome





Go Beyond Dashboards

- Filter what should be automated (core business processes)
- Organize IT & business to partner solving the problem
- Inventory data resources



Tell Smarter Stories

- Use employee experience as filter to identify subset of data to fix
- Define who owns & can access the data
- Combine multiple systems
- Identify minimum data to answer specific questions



Intelligence

Increase

- Define what's worth knowing/receiving notifications about
- Create feedback loop
- Create data team
- Create new hypotheses from data-driven answers





- Formalize feedback loops
- Keep asking new questions based on answers identified
